5. SECTOR-SPECIFIC HEALTH & SAFETY CONTROLS

Manual Handling:

- Tasks involving heavy timber boards are risk assessed
- Staff trained in lifting techniques
- Use of trolleys, forklifts, vacuum lifts where practicable

Fire Safety:

- Fire exits and routes kept clear and well-marked
- Suitable fire extinguishers and alarm systems installed
- Wood dust and offcuts removed regularly
- Fire risk assessments reviewed at least annually

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

- High-visibility clothing, gloves, safety boots, glasses and hearing protection issued as required
- All PPE maintained and replaced when necessary

6. HEALTH & SAFETY ADVISORY SERVICE

To assist in fulfilling our legal duties and maintaining industry best practice, we have appointed:

MICLAN FM Consultants

They function as our Competent Person and provide professional guidance and support, which we follow to ensure ongoing compliance and improvement.

7. FORKLIFT TRUCKS

- Forklifts operated only by trained and certified personnel
- Pre-use checks and regular inspections completed and logged
- Pedestrian walkways and loading zones clearly marked
- Loads securely stacked and evenly distributed
- Safe speed limits enforced in warehouse and yard areas
